Overview:

The Neonatal Resuscitation Program (NRP) is an education program of the American Academy of Pediatrics and the American Heart Association that teaches the concepts and skills of neonatal resuscitation.

This course is designed to cover all nine lessons in the NRP textbook. (Participants may receive credit for the course by completing the minimum course requirement of Lessons 1 through 4 and Lesson 9.) The NRP provider course allows ample time for individualized hands-on skills development and practice with an NRP Instructor. This is an interactive hands on course.

To successfully pass the course, the learner must:

- Pass the written examination.
- Demonstrate neonatal resuscitation skills (minimum Lessons 1 through 4 in the textbook).
- Demonstrate the NRP resuscitation algorithm in correct sequence during the Megacode Assessment

Course participants who do not have job responsibilities for procedures such as intubation or umbilical venous catheter placement may learn about and demonstrate these procedures to enhance their learning experience. **NRP does not certify the learner to perform any technique, imply competence to perform neonatal resuscitation, or determine the participant's scope of practice.**

Objectives:

Participants will be able to:

- Assess and utilize best practices for neonatal resuscitation.
- Differentiate critical components of newborn resuscitation and demonstrate skills in the correct sequence according to the NRP algorithm to optimize neonatal outcomes.
- Reduce newborn morbidity and mortality by demonstrating NRP knowledge, skills, and teamwork by participating in a scenario-based simulated resuscitation.
