### Overview

S.T.A.B.L.E. focuses on the post-resuscitation/pre-transport medical stabilization of premature or sick infants. **S.T.A.B.L.E.** stands for the six assessments and care modules in the program: **S**ugar and safe care, **T**emperature, **A**irway, **B**lood pressure, **L**ab work and **E**motional support.

### Objectives

Upon completion of the course participants will be able to:

- Use the S.T.A.B.L.E. mnemonic to quickly and effectively stabilize newborns.
- Anticipate, recognize and correct common neonatal problems as soon as possible and provide high-quality care, minimizing the chance of adverse outcomes.
- Demonstrate increased knowledge and confidence in infant assessment and skills required to provide timely interventions at critical points in an infant's care.

### Who should attend

Health care professionals working in labor and delivery, newborn nurseries and neonatal intensive care units, as well as emergency medical personnel.

### Course cost
